**Psalm 85:8-13 (NIV)** For the director of music. Of the Sons of Korah. A psalm.

- <sup>8</sup>I will listen to what God the Lord says; he promises peace to his people, his faithful servants but let them not turn to folly.
- <sup>9</sup>Surely his salvation is near those who fear him, that his glory may dwell in our land.

<sup>10</sup>Love and faithfulness meet together; righteousness and peace kiss each other.
<sup>11</sup>Faithfulness springs forth from the earth, and righteousness looks down from heaven.
<sup>12</sup>The Lord will indeed give what is good, and our land will yield its harvest.
<sup>13</sup>Righteousness goes before him and prepares the way for his steps.

## 1. Remembering God's faithfulness.

I will listen to what God the Lord says... but let them not turn to folly

<sup>1</sup>You, Lord, showed favor to your land; you restored the fortunes of Jacob. <sup>2</sup>You forgave the iniquity of your people and covered all their sins. <sup>3</sup>You set aside all your wrath and turned from your fierce anger. <sup>4</sup>Restore us again, God our Savior, and put away your displeasure toward us. <sup>5</sup>Will you be angry with us forever? Will you prolong your anger through all generations? <sup>6</sup>Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you? <sup>7</sup>Show us your unfailing love, Lord, and grant us your salvation. *Psalm 85:1-7 (NIV)* 

I will remember the deeds of the Lord; yes, I will remember your miracles of long ago. *Psalm* 77:11 (*NIV*)

## 2. Trusting the character and generosity of God.

Surely his salvation is near... The Lord will indeed give what is good

Blessed are those you choose and bring near to live in your courts! We are filled with the good things of your house, of your holy temple. <sup>5</sup>You answer us with awesome and righteous deeds, God our Savior, the hope of all the ends of the earth and of the farthest seas. *Psalm* 65:4-5 (*NIV*)

## 3. Seeing God on the journey with us.

Righteousness goes before him and prepares the way for his steps.

A voice of one calling: "In the wilderness prepare the way for the Lord; make straight in the desert a highway for our God. *Isaiah 40:3 (NIV)* 

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; <sup>6</sup>in all your ways submit to] him, and he will make your paths straight. *Proverbs 3:5–6 (NIV)*
