BREATHE Pray a prayer of gratitude.

RETURN How might you open yourself to God's invitation for you? Name the ways God has invited you to reflect the reconciling work of Jesus in the world. Matthew 6:33, Micah 6:8

BREATHE Pray the Lord's Prayer.
