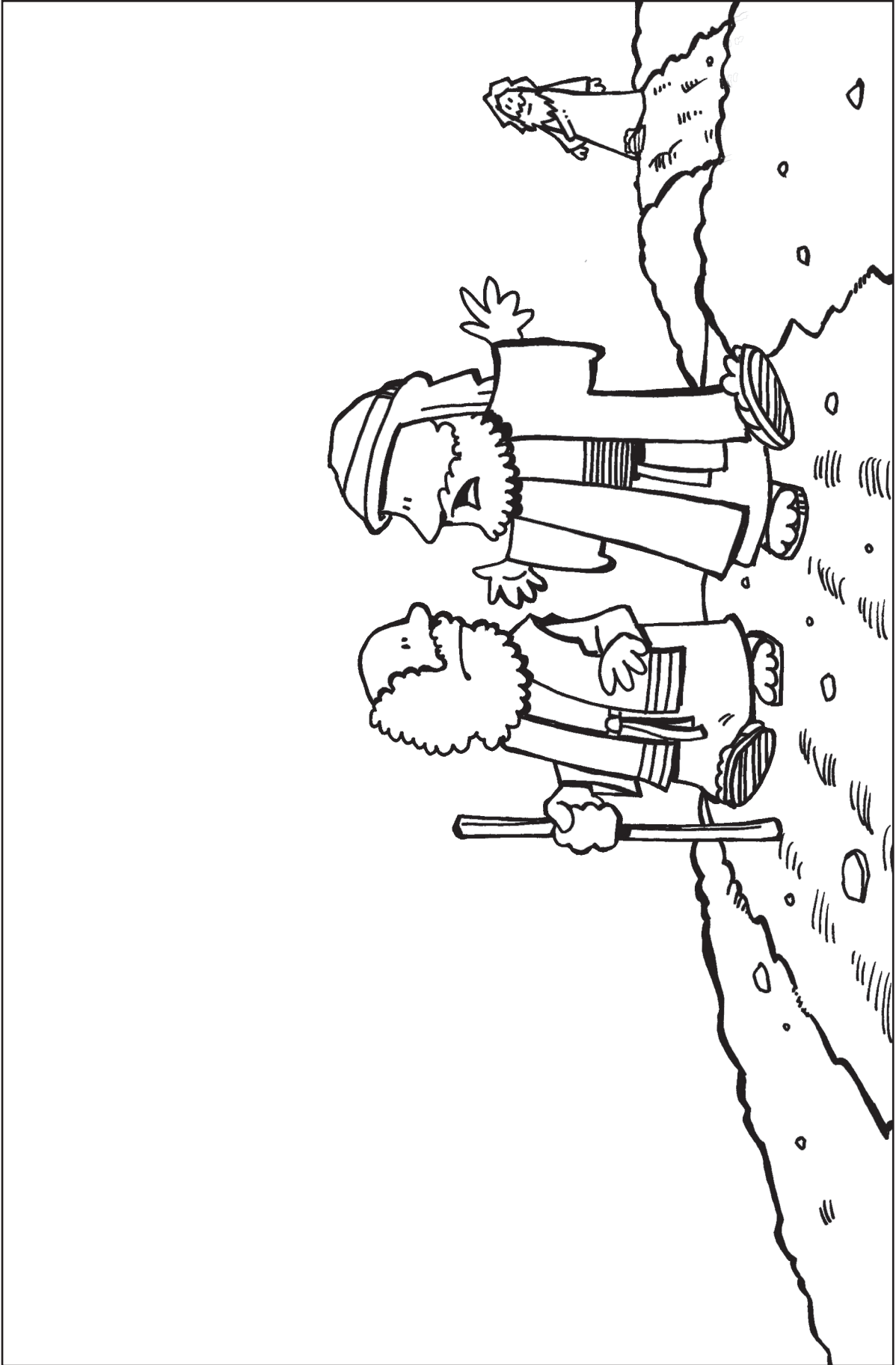

After a while, a stranger began to walk along with them.

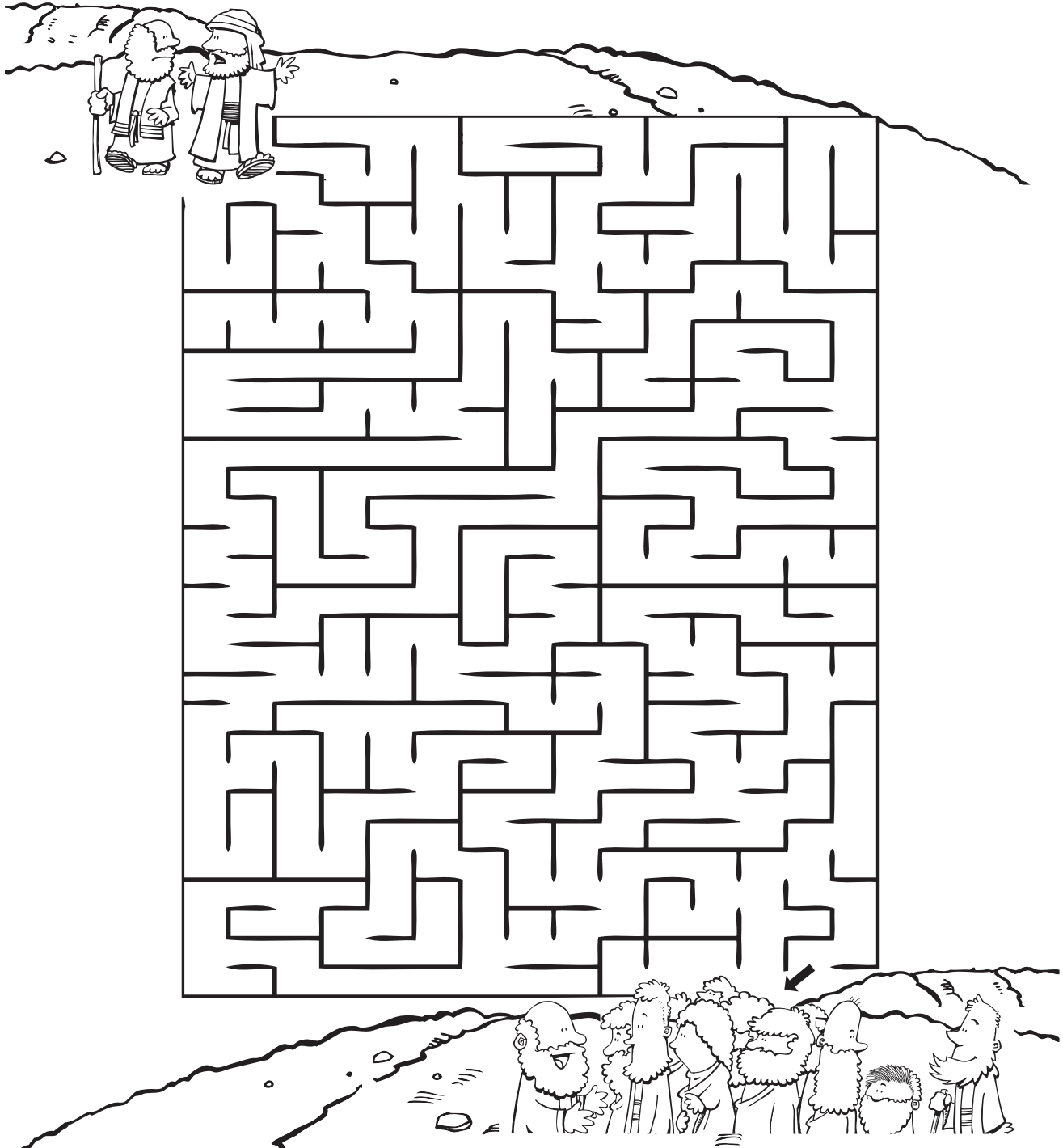
The Road to Emmaus
